

A linear, off-road facility with a permanent alignment that is open to the general public and is designed, constructed, and maintained for use of a variety of non-motorized forms of travel




How We **CONNECT** OBJECTIVE C

Provide universally accessible sidewalks, trails, and public transit connections to create a continuous active transportation network within designated growth areas, and **develop multi-use trails to interconnect all communities.**



Multi-use (Shared-use) Trail

A facility that is physically separated from the roadway and typically accommodates bi-directional travel by both bicyclists and pedestrians. They typically have an improved surface (asphalt, concrete, compacted aggregate, etc.) and have a recommended width of 10 feet, although a minimum of 8 feet may be used where space is constrained or when located in environmentally sensitive areas.



Multi-use (Shared-use) Trail

Width	10'+ preferred, 8' minimum
Grade	<5% longitudinal, <2% cross-slope
Surface	Improved, accessible (Asphalt, Concrete, Compacted Aggregate)
